What you'll need.

Admission requirements for transfer students:

- **"B"** average on the most recent year of study at a recognized institution
- Applicants with completed post-secondary coursework will be assessed for possible transfer credit towards a UVic undergraduate degree
- Programs in the Faculties of Fine Arts and the Faculty of Business require supplemental applications; see www.uvic.ca/programreq for details
- Proof of English language proficiency



What you'll need.

Language proficiency requirement

If your first language is not English you will need to demonstrate English language proficiency prior to admission. This may be done in one of the following ways:

- Submit a minimum TOEFL score of **90** (iBT) with a minimum of **20** on each of the reading, writing, listening and speaking sections, or
- Submit a minimum score of **6.5** on the IELTS – no band less than **6.0**, or
- Complete UVic's University Admission Preparation (UAP) course with a grade of **80%** or higher

What you'll need.

Conditional & Preliminary Admission

Offered with our English Language Centre and open to students applying to the following faculties:

- Engineering
- Humanities
- Science
- Social Sciences

High School graduates who obtain a minimum TOEFL score of 71 or a total IELTS score of 5.5 will also be given a Preliminary Offer of Admission and encouraged to register with UVic's English Language Centre (ELC).

Current high school students or university-transfer students will be considered for Preliminary Admission with a 5.5 IELTS/71 TOEFL and final grades .

Students need to complete the University Admission Preparation (UAP) course with 80% to qualify for admission to a degree program.

- International students can work on campus right away and off campus after six months of full time study. See www.cic.gc.ca for details.
- Students participating in co-operative education (available in almost every program) earn an average of **\$10,800 (CAD)** per four month work term and will work four terms over the course of a degree program.
