

VISA

International visitors to Republic of Singapore must carry a valid passport. Citizens of certain countries do require a Visa to come to Singapore. Each participant is responsible for applying for and obtaining a **Multiple Entry Visa** (Participant will board on Cruise to Malaysia and back to Singapore again, so that Multiple Entry Visa is required) at the nearest Embassy or Consulate of the Republic of Singapore. APPLICATION

Applications are on individual basis, and the criteria of eligibility are described below.

The following are eligible to be a AYLTLC participant:

- Students aged 16-26(at least 16 but not older than 26 of age at the time of AYLTLC 2014) from schools, colleges and universities around the world.
- Students who are healthy, curious, aspirant and outgoing.
- Students who love travelling and learning.

Applicants should also have the following skills and experience:

- · Be fluent in English speaking and writing.
- Have the ability to communicate effectively and express themselves clearly.
- Be comfortable in working in a cooperative manner.

7 REGISTRATION.

APPLICATION

If you are a Student (>26 years old) / Staff / Teacher / Lecturer / Professor from your institution, you may wish to apply AYLTLC 2014 as advisor.

There are two ways for you to register:
