Eligibility for Admission

To be considered for admission to AsTW, applicants must be:

- currently enrolled in a degree program at an accredited university or college outside Japan;
- in good academic standing (with a grade point average of 3.0 out of 4.0 or higher);
- proficient in English for academic purposes (if a non- native speaker, able to demonstrate TOEFL-PBT 530 / TOEFL-iBT 68 / TOEFL-CBT 190 / IELTS-5.5 or the equivalent); and
- planning to continue university study following AsTW.

*We may consider applicants with TOEFL/IELTS scores below the reference scores in order to create more cultural diversity, but that applicant must provide extra proof of English competence.

AsTW Academic Program

AsTW consists of three parts: **ASEAN Studies Courses (ASC), Asian Languages & Cultures (ALC)** and **Study Trips,** providing students with a unique study opportunity.

ASC gives AsTW a distinction as a comprehensive academic program of ASEAN issues that increasingly play an important role in the world and "ASEAN+3" relations.

Students will broaden their knowledge and gain deeper understanding about ASEAN and "ASEAN+3" cooperation through ASC. A valuable part of the program is the opportunity to approach ASEAN and East Asia topics from different perspectives. Students will select one ASC course among those offered below. ASC for 2015 will be taught by professors from Vietnam National University, Hanoi, Kyushu University, and Fukuoka Women's University.

In addition, students will choose one intensive Asian language course. The combination of **ASC and ALC** contributes to the students' synthetic understanding of ASEAN and East Asia.

A series of **Vietnamese cultural study trips** is another attractive part of the program. Each excursion is designed to allow students to experience Vietnamese culture.

To complete AsTW, students must take 2 courses (one ALC and one ASC). Students who complete AsTW will be awarded a certificate jointly issued by Kyushu University and Vietnam National University, Hanoi (VNU).

ASC: ASEAN Studies Courses

2 credits (30 credit hrs) per course

- Current Affairs of ASEAN and East Asia
- ASEAN Economics
- Cross-cultural Communication in Asia

ALC: Asian Languages & Cultures

2 credits (30 credit hrs) per course

- Basic Japanese Language & Culture
- Basic Vietnamese Language & Culture
- Basic Chinese Language & Culture
- English as a communication tool

*All courses are subject to change.

Credit Transfer

Kyushu University will award credit and grades. Official transcripts will be sent to the participants in May 2015. Participants should consult their home universities about transferring credit and grades in advance.

Tuition and Fees

155,000 JPY

Fees include tuition, study trips, accommodation with breakfasts, some banquets and meals as indicated and group airport pick-up/drop-off; exclude the cost of international air fare to and from Hanoi. *All fees are subject to change.

Other Estimated Costs:

Approx 3,200,000 VND (equivalent to 150 USD*) for meals for 16 days at on-campus cafeterias. *at the exchange rate for 1 July, 2014

Scholarship

Kyushu University offers a limited number of scholarships, which cover the tution and fees above, to students who present a strong academic record. All applicants are considered; recipients are selected by Kyushu University.

Accommodation

All students will stay in VNU dormitory on Me Tri Campus (twin-share or four-share occupancy).

Application

Students must arrange for their AsTW application and supporting documents to be received by **October 31, 2014.** The materials to submit include:

- 1) A completed AsTW application form
- 2) An 800 word essay on "Why I want to join AsTW"
- 3) Official academic transcripts of all undergraduate study
- 4) A university or college diploma copy (graduates only)
- 5) One letter of recommendation

(from a teacher other than a language instructor)

6) A copy of a recent official TOEFL, IELTS, or other English assessment report (non-native English speakers only)
