### **Eligibility**

- Undergraduate and graduate students majoring in STEM fields (science, technology, engineering and mathematics) with minimum GPA of 3.0
- English proficiency test score (only for students from non-English speaking schools)
- Have prior research experience at home institution (Preferred)
