

The Master of Public Health(MPH) at The University of Utah Asia Campus

1. Asia Campus

-The University of Utah Asia Campus was inaugurated in September of 2014 on the Incheon Global Campus and currently offers the Master of Public Health Program, which consists of a two years program . The University of Utah Asia Campus is now accepting applications for their Master of Public Health program. The highly ranked University of Utah is extending its world-class education around the globe and the new Asia Campus provides a unique international opportunity to study both in Korea and the USA to earn your MPH. Students will spend the first year at the Incheon, South Korea Campus, which is taught in English by our US faculty and the second year at the Utah Campus in the US. Students who successfully complete all courses will be awarded the US degree.

2. The Master of Public Health

- The MPH program requires a minimum 45 credit hours of coursework. A required practicum of 6 credit hours provides the opportunity for the student to gain real-world experience with an organization conducting public health activities.

2. UAC Scholarships information

Students who admitted to the Asia Campus in 2015 will be automatically eligible to apply for the UAC scholarships. Admitted students may be awarded significant scholarship amounts, up to 25 to 50% of the tuition at the Asia Campus. Scholarship awards will be based on academic preparation and student need.

3. Deadlines

The deadline for the fall semester in 2015 is the 2nd of August.
