



#### 一切從港大「大學科技初創企業資助計劃」開始


對於有創業念頭的人士,香港大學「大學科技初創企業資助計劃」(簡稱TSSSU@HKU)提 供一個黃金機會,他們將自己研發的新技術和發明轉化為商機。這是一項全新的資助計劃,由 創新科技署於2014年10月推出,每年提供總共400萬港元的資金,為香港大學學生、教職員 及畢業生創立的科技初創企業提供資助,對計劃有興趣的科技初創企業可向技術轉移處遞交申 請。港大「大學科技初創企業資助計劃」在2014-15 年度收到了29份申請,當中8個成功獲得 資助,包括「Passber Limited」和「<u>再心生物科技有限公司</u>」,以下是他們分享的創業故 事。

#### 從學生學會到初創企業

一間由大學生創立、以大學生為服務對象的公司, 迅速發展成為一個社交網絡,甚至是價值數十億美 元的企業。聽起來是否似曾相識?要如Facebook 般成功或許是一個遙不可及的夢想,但Andy Leung和Ivan Law 正在逐步實踐這個夢想,他們 推出以學生為目標的服務,並有廣泛應用的潛力。

他們成立「Passber」(「Passport for Member」的簡稱),目的就是使推行會藉模式的 機構如會所有效地管理會籍事務,讓會員更易使用 服務,以及讓一些相關的商業機構或企業接觸到會 員。





「立體人類迷你心臟」從「多能幹細胞」衍生 而來的心臟細胞改造而成,能被心電圖記錄信 號或心臟節律。它能夠像人類心臟一樣運作, 當測到壓力時可泵血,同時對各種神經激素分 泌及藥理刺激產生反應。





<u>李登偉教授(香港大學幹細胞及再生醫學研究中心</u> 總監)以基因工程成功研製了全球首個人類心臟細 胞及首個在實驗室中創造的「立體人類迷你心 臟」。與此同時李教授亦一直致力於將這些嶄新的 技術轉化成產品,讓醫學界以至社會各界共同受 惠。

他成立的「<u>再心生物科技有限公司</u>」(NovoHeart Limited)是一間全球性的幹細胞生物科技公司, 旨在為生物科技產業及醫學界帶來革命性的藥物研 發,從而減低新藥對病人的影響,並且成為新一代 心臟組織和基因工程的研究先鋒。

在以心臟為研究焦點的科研中,新藥研發似乎並非 常見的研究目標。但事實上各種藥物,包括許多治 療癌症的新藥,試驗失敗的主要原因,就是因為對 心臟引致毒性。

李教授表示:「我們的發明能大大縮短試藥時間, 並且不會對病人產生任何不良影響。」





#### 赛卡新沙士都驗到 每塊百餘元獲贊助創業

香港文匯報訊(記者 姜嘉軒)患上流行性感冒會流鼻水、打噴嚏和咳嗽,若不及早阻擋病毒,它會四圍 散播害人。港大團隊研發可攜式疾病檢測晶片「BioCap流感指示片」,只要在襟章大小的晶片塗上抗體,病 者對準它吹氣即會變色,檢測時間可大大縮減至數分鐘,方便醫護人員快速跟進,減低擴散機會。其原理亦 適用於寨卡病毒、中東呼吸綜合症(新沙士)、瘟症等多種疾病,每塊成本只需百多元。項目最近獲得港大 創業種子基金「Dream Catchers 100k」贊助10萬元作為創業資本。

[DreamCatchers 100k]比賽上月圓滿結束,本屆吸引逾300名學生與校友參加,最後選出十組獲勝隊 伍,入圍產品包括「智能監測裝置Peacify」及自動化檢測工具「Project Raphael」(見另稿),各隊伍贏 得10萬元的種子基金,為他們的創業路投下第一筆資金。
