Poznan University of Technology (PUT) grew out of the State School of Mechanical Engineering which was established in 1919. Currently, it is one of the leading technical universities in Poland which has become one of the most recognized landmarks of the region and even the whole country. Our mission is to provide personnel highly qualified in wider understanding of engineering, closely related to research, technology development and innovation in partnership with the economy and society:

- in the top five Polish public universities chosen by students and as well as the first seven universities whose graduates are acting as CEOs of large companies

Required documents:

- application form,
- confirmation of the English knowledge- It may be either an official certificate or a confirmation from your home university (required level - B2),
- after receiving confirmation of registration You will receive our account number.

Deadline for registration: 08.04.2018

Payment until: 15.04.2018

What is the price?

550 EUR per participant

The fee covers:

- costs of participation in courses: tuition, workshops, laboratory activities, trips, tours, entertainment, accommodation at PUT's dormitories, two meals per day (breakfast, lunch) and public transport.

Participant has to cover any additional cost as p.ex.: health and accident insurance, other meals, optional program (English course/ one-day or a two-day trip to Warsaw / Berlin)
